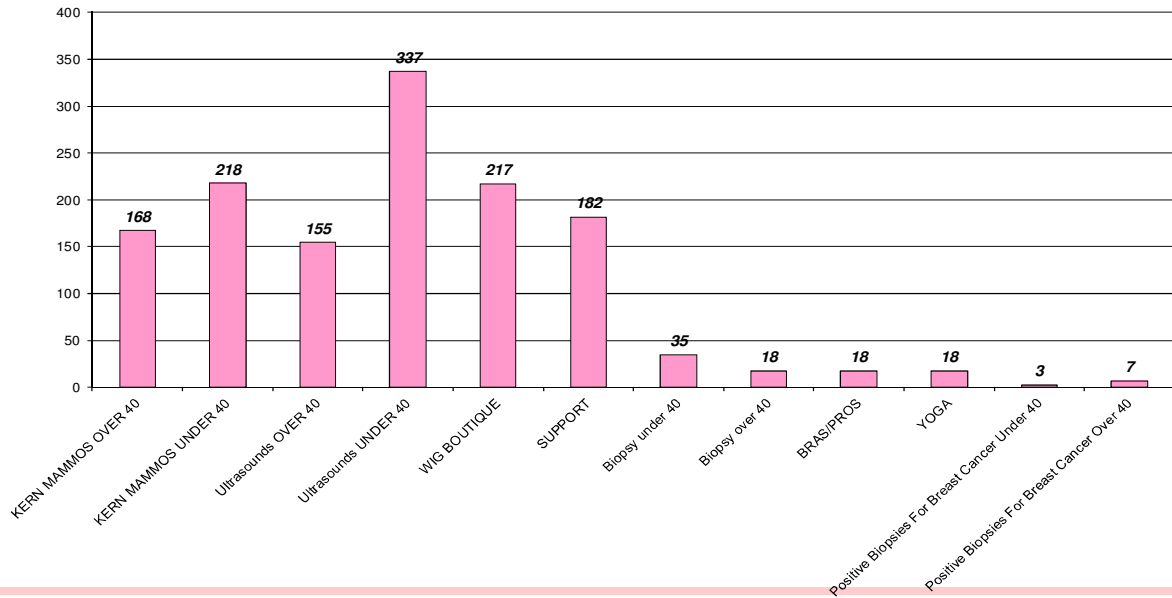
Links for Life has participated in CSUB's pink soccer, basketball, and softball games. The teams have held jersey auctions with the proceeds going to Links.
